Who we are & What we do

We are Sheffield's young people's substance misuse service. We provide 1-1 support, treatment and education to young people under 19 in the Sheffield area who are experiencing problems with drugs and alcohol.

We are a fully integrated service within Sheffield Community Youth Teams and Sheffield Youth Justice. This means we joint work with other youth services around the city, in order to support young people effectively.

We offer screening, full assessment and treatment for substance misuse problems. We are happy to offer support at our city centre and community bases, at clients' homes or any other suitable venue.

We deliver group work sessions for young people which provide education and advice to prevent and reduce the harms of drugs and alcohol.

We also deliver training sessions to others working with young people in Sheffield. Please see further details in this leaflet.

We offer a flexible and accessible service. We offer telephone support for young people, family members/concerned others and professionals.

We have a prescribing service and we offer prescribing treatment to young people. We also offer harm reduction advice to clients who are injecting.
